RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On May 16, 2016 the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority Revitalization Corporation ("Corporation") filed before the Puerto Rico Energy Commission ("Commission") its response to the testimonies filed by intervenors on May 9, 2016. The Corporation's response consists of rebuttal testimonies from Corporation witnesses.

Among them, the Corporation filed rebuttal testimony of Corporation witness Michael Mace¹ stating that "[t]he estimated costs are consistent in type and, as a percentage of debt, in amount with other large restructuring transactions and other large securitization transactions."² However, Mr. Mace's testimony fails to provide details and documentation in support of this assertion and which demonstrate that the estimated costs are consistent in type and amount with costs associated with other similar financial transactions.

As such, the Corporation is hereby **ORDERED** to provide such supporting documentation **on or before May 23, 2016 at 4:00 p.m.** The documentation requested herein shall be filed via email to the following addresses: legal@energia.pr.gov and afigueroa@energia.pr.gov, and must be notified to all intervenors.

For the benefit of all parties involved, the Commission issues this Resolution and Order in both Spanish and English languages. Should any discrepancy between each version arise, the content and provisions of the Spanish version shall prevail.

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
