TIME TO PUBLISH NOTICE REGARDING
PUBLIC HEARINGS

RESOLUTION

On April 25, 2016, the Puerto Rico Energy Commission ("Commission") issued a Resolution and Order setting forth the procedural calendar applicable to the evaluation of the Verified Petition for Restructuring Order and requiring the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority's Revitalization Corporation ("Corporation") to publish, on or before April 29, 2016, the corresponding public notice pursuant to the provisions of Article 6.25A of Act 57-2014.¹ The content of the public notice was provided by the Commission along with the Resolution and Order.

On April 28, 2016, the Corporation filed a motion requesting the Commission to grant until May 9, 2016 for the Corporation to publish the public notice since the Puerto Rico State Elections Commission had not yet given its approval to publishing the notice, pursuant to the Puerto Rico Electoral Law provisions.² The Corporation stated that the time extension requested therein would not be contrary to the provisions of Article 6.25A of Act 57-2014 since the notice would be published no less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date in which the public hearing is to be held.³

Pursuant to the aforementioned, the Commission hereby grants the Corporation's request, provided that the Corporation shall have until **Friday, May 6, 2016** to publish the notice as provided by the Commission. The Corporation shall notify the Commission copy of said notice within three (3) days from the date it is first published.

For the benefit of all the parties involved, the Commission issues this Resolution in both Spanish and English languages. Should any discrepancy between each version arise, the content and provisions of the Spanish version shall prevail.

¹ Act No. 57 of May 27, 2014, as amended, known as the Puerto Rico Energy Transformation and RELIEF Act.

² Act No. 78 of June 1, 2011, as amended, known as the Puerto Rico Electoral Law, and the applicable regulation on advertisement expenses approved by the State Elections Commission set forth the rules applicable to the publishing of notices by government agencies during electoral years.

³ Sub-section (f)(1) of Act 57-2014 provides that the public notice related to the public hearings shall be published no less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date in which such hearings are to be held.
