RESOLUTION

On April 26, 2016, the Puerto Rico Energy Commission (“Commission”) issued a Resolution notifying its determination regarding various petitions to intervene. On said occasion, the Commission determined to deny the petition to intervene filed by Dr. Guillermo Riera (“Dr. Riera”) on the grounds that: (i) the petition failed to comply with the requirements set forth by the Commission for granting a petition to intervene since the petition failed to address any of the criterion established in the April 13, 2016 Resolution and Order; (ii) the petition failed to comply with the filing and notification requirements set forth in the April 13, 2016 Resolution and Order and Regulation 8543 regarding Adjudicative Procedures (“Regulation 8543”); and (iii) the petition failed to identify a legitimate interest in the current proceeding which justified Dr. Riera’s intervention.<sup>1</sup>

Dissatisfied with the Commission’s determination, on April 28, 2016, Dr. Riera filed a motion requesting the Commission to reconsider its determination denying the petition to intervene.<sup>2</sup> Justifying his plea for reconsideration, Dr. Riera’s motion addressed many of the deficiencies noted by the Commission on its April 26, 2016 Resolution. However, to allow the Commission to fully evaluate the merits of Dr. Riera’s motion for reconsideration, Dr. Riera is hereby ordered to provide further information with regards to the nature of his participation during this proceeding.<sup>3</sup> Specifically, Dr. Riera must describe in detail the extent of his participation and intervention before, during and after the Technical Hearing.

Pursuant to the aforementioned, Dr. Riera must file a supplemental motion **on or before Tuesday, May 3, 2016 at 4:00 p.m.**

<sup>1</sup> Although the Commission denied Dr. Riera’s petition, in doing so we compelled Dr. Riera to provide his comments and recommendations through the use of the written comments mechanism and to participate during the Public Comments Hearing.

Although the April 26, 2016 Resolution and Order did not consider the filing of a motion for reconsideration, the proper remedy being judicial review before the Court of Appeals, the Commission, in full use of its discretion and powers, determined to address Dr. Riera’s motion for reconsideration.

<sup>3</sup> Section 3.5 of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act, Act 170-1988, as amended, provides that the Commission has the authority to request any party seeking intervention in an adjudicative procedure to provide additional information in support of his/her request. 3 L.P.R.A. §2155.
