RESOLUTION


On June 3, 2016, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority Revitalization Corporation ("Corporation") filed a request for extension of the due date imposed by the Puerto Rico Energy Commission ("Commission") to present its final brief in relation to the evaluation proceeding of the Petition for Restructuring Order ("Petition") presented by the Corporation.¹ Succinctly, the Corporation argued that it will present an alternative proposal for the rate design of the Transition Charge on June 6, 2016 pursuant to the Resolution and Order issued on such matter by the Commission on June 1, 2016, and the content of such proposal will be the subject of a telephone conference call on June 9, 2016 for which the time and other details will be announced by the Commission at a later date.

In order for its final brief to contemplate the insight and recommendations resulting from said telephone conference, the Corporation requests that it be granted until June 10, 2016 to file its final brief on the matter for review before the Commission. In light of the above, and for the benefit of all the parties, the Commission **GRANTS** the request for extension presented by the Corporation. Accordingly, both the Corporation and **all intervenors** must file their final briefs **on or before June 10, 2016, by 4:30 p.m.** The present extension of time to present briefs applies equally to the **general public**. Therefore, the public's written comments shall be received by the Commission no later than **June 10, 2016, at 4:30 p.m.**

For the benefit of all the parties involved, the Commission publishes the present Resolution in Spanish and English. If there is any discrepancy between both versions, the Spanish version prevails.

Be it notified and published.

¹ Through a Resolution and Order issued on April 25, 2016, the Commission granted the Corporation and all intervenors until June 6, 2016 to file their final briefs.

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
