SUBJECT: Extension of time to file legal
briefs and written comments

RESOLUTION

During the Technical Hearing held from the 24th to the 27th of May, 2016, the Puerto Rico Energy Commission ("Commission") and participating intervenors expressed their concerns with regards to the possible impact that the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority Revitalization Corporation's ("Corporation") decision would have by using a fixed charge for the imposition of the proposed Transition Charge on residential customers, especially its impact on residential customers who have a Subsidized Fixed Rate or who have net metering agreements. On June 1st, 2016, the Commission ordered the Corporation to file a proposal for an alternate Transition Charge design which would address the concerns expressed during the Technical Hearing. On June 6, 2016, the Corporation filed its proposal for an alternate Transition Charge design.

In essence, the Corporation's alternate proposal provides for a Transition Charge for residential customers based on consumption, rather than a fixed charge as originally proposed, and takes into account the provisions of Act 22-2016¹ regarding residential subsidies and Act 114-2007², as amended, regarding net metering agreements. Accordingly, residential customers benefiting from a Subsidized Fixed Rate will only be charged a Transition Charge for the excess of the consumption established for each customer, in accordance with the parameters of Act 22-2016. On the other hand, the customers with net metering agreements who comply with the provisions of Article 4 of Act 114-2007, as amended, will be charged a Transition Charge on their net consumption billed by the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority.

On June 9, 2016, the Commission held a clarification conference in relation to the alternate Transition Charge proposal filed by the Corporation. During said conference, representatives from the Commission, Corporation and intervenors had the opportunity to

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participate in a questions and answers session aimed at clarifying the content and nature of the alternate proposal filed by the Corporation.

In light of the aforementioned, and with the purpose of providing ample opportunity for the parties and the general public to express their opinions and concerns with regards to the Corporation's proposal, the Commission hereby determines the following:

1. The **Corporation** shall have **until June 14th, 2016, at 4:30 p.m.**, to file its legal brief and supporting documents.
2. **Intervenors** and the **general public** shall have **until June 16th, 2016, at 4:30 p.m.**, to file their legal briefs or written public comments, respectively.

For the benefit of all the parties involved, this Resolution and Order is published in both Spanish and English languages. Should any discrepancy between each version arise, the content and provisions of the Spanish version shall prevail.





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
