SUBJECT: Appointment of Hearing Examiner;
Technical Conference Format.

RESOLUTION

On July 2, 2018, the Puerto Rico Energy Commission (“Commission”) issued an Order establishing the procedure for the Pre-filing Process of the Integrated Resource Plan (“IRP”), pursuant Section 3.01 of Regulation 9021.¹ As established in the Order, the Commission will hold a Public Technical Conference on **August 14, 2018 at 8:30 a.m.** at the Commission’s Hearing Room, located at Seaborne Plaza, 268 Muñoz Rivera Ave., 8th floor, San Juan, P.R. The purpose of the Technical Conference is for the Commission to ensure that the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority’s (“PREPA”) IRP filing will comply with the requirements of Regulation 9021, such that it complies with public policy goals, as well as the Commission’s expectations.

I. Appointment of Hearing Examiner

Pursuant to Article 6.11 of Act 57-2014,² the Commission hereby appoints Sylvia B. Ugarte Araujo, *Esq.* as hearing examiner for the Technical Conference. As such, attorney Ugarte shall have the power and the responsibility to preside over the Technical Conference, to administer oaths and to receive documents.

II. Technical Conference Format

During the Technical Conference, PREPA shall present an overview of the methodology and subjects that are being evaluated as part of the IRP proposal. In order to maximize the time available for the Technical Conference, PREPA must file an electronic copy of its presentation with the Commission’s Clerk (secretaria@energia.pr.gov) **on or before August 10, 2018.**

The Commission, as it has done in other proceedings, will organize the questioning of PREPA’s witnesses by subject-matter. This approach allows for a more useful dialogue, a more organized hearing record, provides for better time management and allows for a more detailed and efficient examination of the information presented. Furthermore, as part of the Technical Conference the Commission will provide an opportunity for PREPA to seek clarification regarding the compliance requirements, as set forth in Regulation 9021.


