**RESOLUTION**

On March 14, 2019, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau of the Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a proposal for the Regulation for Electric Cooperatives in Puerto Rico. The public notice announcing the proposed Regulation and the instructions on public participation was published in the newspaper *Primera Hora* on March 15, 2019.

Pursuant to the provisions of Act 38-2017,<sup>1</sup> the Energy Bureau granted the general public a term of thirty (30) days, starting from the publication date of the March 15, 2019 notice, to submit comments in writing or request a public hearing about the Regulation. In order to provide interested parties with further opportunity to submit comments to the proposed Regulation, the Energy Bureau hereby extends the period for public comments by thirty (30) additional days from the date of publication of a new notice to be issued by the Energy Bureau.
