SUBJECT: PETITIONS FOR INTERVENTION  
IN THE INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLAN  
ASSESSMENT PROCEEDING

**RESOLUTION**

On July 29, 2015, PVP Properties, Inc., Coto Laurel Solar Farm, Inc., Windmar PV Energy, Inc., and Windmar Renewable Energy, Inc. (collectively, "Windmar"), filed a *Petición de Intervención*, or petition to intervene, in the Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) assessment proceeding before the Puerto Rico Energy Commission (Commission). Through a Resolution issued on August 19, 2015 we stated that Windmar's petition was incomplete for not addressing the four points required in Section 3.02 (B) of Regulation No. 8594, known as the Regulation on Integrated Resource Plan for the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (Regulation 8594), and not providing sufficient grounds in support of the petition. On that occasion, the Commission ordered Windmar to supplement its petition to intervene on or before September 1, 2015, in accordance to Section 3.02 of Regulation 8594 and the provisions of Act No. 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, known as the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act.

In compliance with the Commission's August 19 Resolution, on September 1, 2015, Windmar filed a *Petición Suplementaria de Intervención*, or supplemental petition to intervene. On the same date, EcoEléctrica, L.P. (EcoEléctrica) also filed a Petition to Intervene in the matter at bar.

Having examined Windmar's *Petición Suplementaria de Intervención* and EcoEléctrica's Petition to Intervene, we find that both petitions are complete, timely filed, duly grounded and comply with the requirements of Section 3.02 (B) of Regulation 8594. Moreover, based on the arguments presented on their petitions, the Commission concludes that both parties will make important contributions to the full development of the proceeding and will not unduly prolong it.





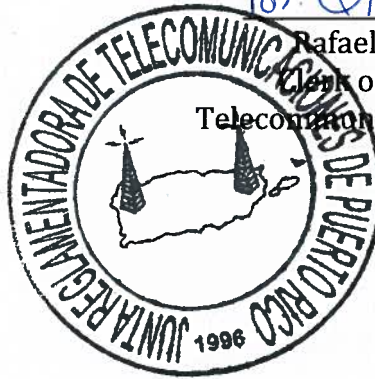
