SUBJECT: Request for Extension of Time from
ELAC and Arctas.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On May 24, 2017, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (“PREPA”) filed several responses to the Request for Information (“ROI”) made by Arctas Capital Group, LP (“Arctas”), as ordered by the Puerto Rico Energy Commission (“Commission”) on its May 22, 2017 Order in the instant proceeding. On the same date, PREPA requested an extension of time to complete its responses to the ROIs made by Arctas and Enlace Latino de Acción Climática, El Puente de Williamsburg, Inc. and Comité de Diálogo Ambiental, Inc. (“ELAC”).¹ In its request, PREPA states that given that both intervenors submitted an extensive number of ROIs and the personnel responsible of working with these requests is unavailable, it needs until June 7, 2017 to submit the remaining responses.

On May 25, 2017, ELAC filed a Motion for Extension of Time, in which it requested the Commission to extend the deadline to submit the testimony on parties analysis’ ten (10) days after PREPA completes the remaining ROIs. In its Motion, ELAC argues that PREPA presented some answers to ELAC’s ROI, but did not provide any related documents,² objected multiple questions and requested additional time to complete the responses.

On May 26, 2017, Arctas filed a *Request to Adjust Accordingly the Schedule for Intervenors to File Testimony on PREPA’s Economic Analysis*. In it request, Arctas states that it does not object to the additional time that PREPA requested to complete the remaining ROIs, but that the procedural calendar in the instant proceeding should be adjusted accordingly to give the parties sufficient time to present a complete testimony. Furthermore, Arctas states that filing incomplete testimony will be a disadvantage to Arctas, as well as to other parties, which will affect the purpose of the instant proceeding.

In light of the aforementioned, the Commission **ORDERS** PREPA to complete the remaining ROIs from ELAC and Arctas **on or before June 6, 2017**. Furthermore, the Commission modifies the Procedural Calendar in the instant proceeding as follows:

Testimony on parties' analysis – PREPA and intervenors may file testimony on any party's analysis on or before June 2, 2017.

Supplemental Testimony on parties' analysis – Any party may file supplemental testimony on any party's analysis on or before June 9, 2017.

Reply to Testimony on parties' analysis – Any party who received comments on their proposal by PREPA or other intervenors, may file responses to such comments on or before June 9, 2017.

Technical Hearing – The Commission will hold a Technical Hearing in which parties will have the opportunity to participate in a session of questions about the testimonies filed as part of the economic analysis presented. The hearing will be held from **June 12, 2017 to June 14, 2017** at the Commission's Hearing Room, Seaborne Building, 268 Ave. Muñoz Rivera, 8th Floor. The Commission will provide at a later date all information regarding the format of the technical hearing, including the applicable rules of behavior and the order of the proceedings.

Final Substantive and Legal Briefs – PREPA and Intervenors may file their substantive and legal briefs **on or before June 21, 2017**.

The Commission clarifies that PREPA will have the opportunity to reply to any supplemental testimony filed by intervenors during the Technical Hearing or the Final Substantive and Legal Briefs.

Format for testimony on parties' analysis

In order to guarantee the orderly management of the instant proceeding, the Commission issues the following instructions with regards to the format of the parties' testimony.

1. Testimonies must be filed in a question and answer format.
2. Testimonies must be filed in "Cambria" or "Times New Roman" font, size 12, double space and each line and page must be numbered.
3. The person appearing as witness must be clearly identified and must provide his/her credentials and must specify the issue or subject on which he/she is testifying.
4. All testimonies must be sworn and verified before a notary public.
5. Searchable PDF version of such testimonies must be provided to the Commission and to all other parties.

For the benefit of all the parties involved, the Commission issues this Resolution and Order in both English and Spanish languages. Should any discrepancy between each version arise, the English version shall prevail.
