MATTER: Motion filed by Petitioner seeking relief for alleged PREPA Non-Compliance with Commission Final Resolution and Order

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On August 17, 2017, the Puerto Rico Energy Commission (“Commission”) issued a Final Resolution and Order in the instant proceeding ordering PREPA to “accept [Petitioner’s] November 2, 2016 objection and conduct an investigation into [Petitioner’s] claims.”¹ The Commission further ordered PREPA to “[i]n addressing [Petitioner’s] objection, [...] follow the provisions of Act 33 [of June 27, 1985, as amended] and [PREPA] Regulation 7982² and [...] grant [Petitioner] all procedural safeguards contemplated therein.”³

Act 33 and Regulation 7982 directs PREPA to “[o]nce an objection is filed, [...] conduct an investigation and notify, in writing, the results of such investigation within sixty (60) days from the date the objection is filed.”⁴

On February 27, 2018, Petitioner filed a Motion notifying the Commission that the above referenced 60-day term began on August 18, 2017, and, taking into consideration the September 2017 hurricanes, ended “on or about January 9th, 2018”. Petitioner also stated that PREPA had failed to conclude and notify the results of its investigation within the required 60-day term. Accordingly, in light of PREPA alleged non-compliance, Petitioner moves the Commission to summarily rule in his favor.

The Commission hereby **ORDERS** PREPA to **SHOW CAUSE** as to (i) why the Commission should not find PREPA to be in violation of the Commission’s August 17 Final Resolution and Order, Act 33, and Chapter XIII of Regulation No. 7982, and impose applicable administrative fines and penalties, and (ii) why the Commission should not direct PREPA to



conclude its investigation into Petitioner's objection within a term not to exceed twenty days from the date it is so ordered.
