**RESOLUTION**

On November 27, 2018 the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (“PREPA”) submitted before the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Energy Bureau”) a document titled *PREPA’s Motion for Expedited Clarification* (“Motion”). In the Motion PREPA request clarification on a statement put forth by the Energy Bureau on the November 21, 2018 Resolution and Order on the instant case (“Resolution and Order”).

On the Resolution and Order, the Energy Bureau stated its determination would be valid contingent on “the conversion of Units 5 and 6 be included in all scenarios of the upcoming IRP filing on a realistic timeline”. The Energy Bureau is by no means trying to affect the 2018 IRP timeline and stresses that a further delay on said timeline will not be acceptable. The intention of the Energy Bureau is for PREPA to include the conversion to the San Juan Generating Units 5 & 6 on **all applicable** scenarios of the 2018 IRP on a timeline that reflects the projected schedule presented on the proposal been considered. As such, the conversion of San Juan Units 5 and 6 should not be considered on any scenario that assumes there is no gas available to the North.
