Order

On February 4, 2019, Respondent, Puerto Electric Power Authority (“PREPA”), filed an Answer to the Administrative Complaint in the aforementioned case. In accordance with Section 9.02 of Regulation 8543¹, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Bureau”) **Orders** both parties to appear at a Pre-Hearing Conference (“Conference”) to be held on **April 25, 2019, at 9:00 a.m.** Also, the parties shall appear at an Administrative Hearing to be held on **April 26, 2019, at 9:00 a.m.** Both hearings will be held at the Bureau’s Hearing Room located at the Seaborne Plaza Building, 268 Ave. Muñoz Rivera, San Juan, Puerto Rico.

The Parties shall have ten (10) days from the date this order is notified, to inform of any conflict with the aforesaid dates, in which case they shall provide three (3) alternate dates for the holding of the Conference or the Administrative Hearing, as the case may be. The parties are advised that failure to appear in the Administrative Hearing may result in the dismissal of the case or the exclusion of the allegations, and as such, the Bureau may issue any order that it deems appropriate.

The parties will have until April 10, 2019 to conclude the discovery process pursuant to Article VIII of Regulation 8543. If a controversy arises related to the discovery process, the parties are ordered to meet and in good faith try to resolve the matter before filing any motions to our consideration. The Bureau will deal with disputes that arise from the discovery process only after certifying that a reasonable effort has been made to solve them.

Finally, the report required by section 9.01 (B) of Regulation 8543 must be submitted by e-mail to: Secretaria@energia.pr.gov on or before **April 22, 2019**. The parties are required to make all the necessary efforts to stipulate as many facts and evidence as possible. If the report is not received as required on the scheduled date, the Conference can

be suspended, and the Bureau has the discretion to impose sanctions.
