**PREPA'S INFORMATIVE MOTION REGARDING THE ITEMS
IN THE ENERGY BUREAU'S JUNE 11th ORDER**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") and respectfully submits, to the honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (the "Energy Bureau"), PREPA's Informative Motion Regarding the Items in the Energy Bureau's June 11th Order. In the interests of time and simplicity, PREPA will address the items in sequence.

1. In PREPA's June 7th filing with the Energy Bureau, IRP Attachment A is included at the end of the ".pdf" of the IRP main Report. This fact can be confirmed by clicking on this link on the Energy Bureau's web site and then clicking on that pdf.

2. The reference to IRP Attachment B is an error in the June 7th IRP cover filing and on page 10-10 of the IRP main Report. Attachment B does not exist. The IRP was going to include an Attachment B, providing the detailed list of Priority 1 and Priority 2 transmission line and substation investment projects. However, as the IRP was finalized, Siemens PTI concluded that Attachment B would be redundant with information in IRP Appendix 1. So, Attachment B was not intended to be referenced in the cover filing and on page 10-10 of the IRP main Report.

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3. With respect to the IRP electronic work papers, please see PREPA's June 11th Informative Motion and Motion to Coordinate Overlapping Schedules. The Informative Motion part of that filing addresses the subject of the IRP electronic work papers and proposes their submission on a rolling basis ending on June 14th. That proposal is consistent with the Energy Bureau's June 11th Order, except that the latter sets a cutoff time of 12:00 p.m. on June 14th. PREPA respectfully requests that the cutoff time be extended to 4:30 p.m. on June 14th.

4. Finally, with respect to the required document regarding how the IRP filing addresses the items in Appendices A and B of the Energy Bureau's March 14th order, Siemens PTI is working on finalizing that document as soon as possible. The document is quite complicated, given the number of references, and Siemens is working to verify the references. PREPA will submit the document by 12:00 p.m. on June 14th as required by the June 11th order.

5. PREPA also wishes to acknowledge that the June 7th IRP cover filing incorrectly referred to IRP Appendix 2. The Energy Bureau's March 14th order waived the requirement to supply Appendix 2.



WHEREFORE, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority respectfully requests that the Honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau accept this Informative Motion, grant PREPA's June 11th Motion; grant until 4:30 p.m. on June 14th for completion of submission of the electronic work papers; and, enter such other relief as is warranted.
