**PREPA'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE
IRP MAIN REPORT "ERRATA" VERSION**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") and respectfully submits, to the honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (the "Energy Bureau"), PREPA's Motion for Leave to File IRP Main Report "Errata" Version.

1. The IRP main Report "errata" version simply corrects a relatively limited number of typographical, wording, formatting, and reference (e.g., exhibit numbers) errors in the IRP main Report filed on June 7, 2019. The IRP main Report "errata" version does not make any substantive changes in the IRP main Report filed on June 7, 2019. A copy of the IRP main Report "errata" version is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

2. A copy of a comparison document that compares the IRP main Report filed on June 7, 2019, with the IRP main Report "errata" version is attached hereto as Exhibit 2. This comparison document shows the changes made.

3. Please note that the IRP main Report "errata" version, because it simply makes non-substantive corrections, bears the same date, June 7, 2019, as the version filed on June 7, 2019. To differentiate the "errata" version: (1) the IRP main Report cover

page date has been changed from "Rev. [2] 6/7/2019" to "Rev. [2.1] 6/7/2019 Corr." and (2) the Revision History chart that immediately follows the cover page has a new row.

4. PREPA respectfully requests approval of the submission of the IRP main Report "errata" version.


5. PREPA also respectfully submits that, because the IRP main Report "errata" version makes no substantive changes, it should not affect the Energy Bureau's timeline for a compliance determination regarding the June 2019 IRP filing.

WHEREFORE, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority respectfully requests that the Honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau grant the foregoing Motion, approve filing of the IRP main Report "errata" version; and, enter such other relief as is warranted.
