SUBJECT: Operational Report Filing.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On April 1, 2019, Sunnova Energy Corporation (“Sunnova”) filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) its operational report for year 2019, pursuant to the provisions on Section 2.02(A) of Regulation 8701.¹ In its filing, Sunnova requested an extension of time to pay the operational report filing fees. On April 2, 2019, the Energy Bureau received the corresponding payment of the filing fees even though it did not inform the Energy Bureau through the Clerk’s Office.

Section 2.02 (E) of Regulation 8701 establishes that “[e]lectric service companies shall refer their Operational Report to the [Energy Public Policy Program (“EPPP”)] for review and comments prior to submitting it to the Energy [Bureau]. When submitting their Operational Reports before the [Energy Bureau], electric service companies shall indicate whether they referred it to the EPPP for review and comments.” In addition, Section 2.02 (E)(2) of Regulation 8701 establishes that “[i]n cases where electric service companies have not referred their Operational Report to the EPPP prior to filing it before the [Energy Bureau], the electric service companies shall explain the reasons that justify them not having made said referral.”

Even though Sunnova stated that their operational report was referred to the EPPP, no evidence of such referral was filed before the Energy Bureau. Therefore, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** Sunnova to, **within five (5) days** of the notification of this Resolution and Order, present evidence of the submittal of its operational report before the EPPP. The Energy Bureau **WARNS** Sunnova that noncompliance with the Energy Bureau orders and Regulations is sufficient cause for imposing fines and other administrative penalties, under Act 57-2014² and all applicable regulations.
