RESOLUTION

On August 9, 2019, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *PREPA's Compliance Filing re August 6, 2019, Order* ("Compliance Filing"). Through its Compliance Filing, PREPA provided additional information regarding Task 3 of the Contract Release 9 ("CR-9"), as ordered in the August 6, 2019 Resolution and Order in the instant case.¹

PREPA explains that Siemens provides other expert technical support to PREPA that may not be directly related to the pending work in the instant case. PREPA states, that Siemens support PREPA on planning items and productions costs analysis that require specialized software that PREPA currently does not have. In specific, PREPA states that Task 3 of the CR-9 was requested by its Planning directorate to support their functions and not necessarily the IRP. However, PREPA concludes that the resulting information may be also useful in relation to the IRP.

Upon review of PREPA's Compliance Filing, the Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of the information submitted. As stated in the August 6, Resolution and Order, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** PREPA leave to execute CR-9. Furthermore, the Energy Bureau places PREPA on notice that the assessment performed under Task 3 of the CR-9 will be required by the Energy Bureau through the discovery process in the instant case.
