MOTION IN COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER DATED AUGUST 16, 2019

TO THE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority through the undersigned legal representation and respectfully sets forth and pray.:

1. On August 13, 2019, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (PREPA) informed the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (the "Bureau") that attorneys Maralíz Vázquez and Katiuska Bolanos had been requested to appear as its legal representative in the case of caption. *See Notice of Appearance on Behalf of the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority* filed on August 13, 2019.
2. On August 16, 2019, the Bureau entered a *Resolution and Order* directing PREPA to "clarify if the legal representation announced on August 14, 2019 is in addition of PREPA's internal legal representation or whether attorneys Vazquez and Bolanos will be the sole attorneys of record for PREPA in the instant case[]" (the "Order").
3. In compliance with the Order, PREPA hereby informs the Bureau that attorneys Maralíz Vázquez and Katiuska Bolaños have joined, rather than substitute, PREPA's in-house legal representation in the case of caption.

WHEREFORE, PREPA requests the Bureau to note the above stated.
