RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On August 7, 2019, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *PREPA's Partial Compliance Filing RE July 23, 2019, Order, and Motion for Leave to Supplement Filing by August 16, 2019* ("Motion"). PREPA requested an extension of time, until August 16, 2019, to file further analysis needed for Siemens to provide complete and correct information to the Energy Bureau on the AES-related modeling and information.

As of the date of the issuance of this Resolution and Order, PREPA has not provided complete and correct information regarding the assessment of a possible fuel conversion in the AES plant. Therefore, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** PREPA to, **on or before 12:00 p.m. of August 23, 2019**, file the complete assessment, including all LTCE modeling results, of the possible fuel conversion of the AES plant.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** PREPA that noncompliance with the provisions of this Resolution and Order will be construed as a violation of the Energy Bureau's orders and may result in the imposition of administrative fines up to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) per day, per violation, as well as any other administrative sanctions the Energy Bureau deems necessary, in accordance with the applicable statutes and regulations.
