SUBJECT: Procedural Calendar and Public
Comment Process Modification.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

Through the August 21, 2019 Resolution and Order in the instant case, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board amended the procedural calendar for the instant case. Among other things, the Energy Bureau established that the Evidentiary Hearing will be held on December 2 – 6.

Paragraph (A) of Section 7.01 of Regulation 8543¹ establishes that all *amicus curiae* briefs shall “be presented at least thirty (30) days before the date on which the administrative hearing shall be held.” Based upon the new Evidentiary Hearing schedule, the Energy Bureau hereby **AMENDS** the deadline for the filing of *Amicus Curiae* briefs. The *Amicus Curiae* briefs required by Section 7.01 of Regulation 8543 must be filed **on or before November 1, 2019**.

Furthermore, in order to foment the participation of the general public in the instant case, the Energy Bureau **DETERMINES** it is appropriate to expand the ways in which the public can submit its written comments. Therefore, any person interested in presenting their comments to the Energy Bureau regarding this proceeding shall comply with the following:

All comments must be presented **on or before 5:00 p.m., January 10, 2020**. Public comments may be presented using the Energy Bureau’s electronic filing tool at: <https://radicacion.energia.pr.gov/>; by electronic mail at comentarios@energia.pr.gov; by postal mail addressed to the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau’s Clerk’s Office at **World Plaza Building, 268 Muñoz Rivera Ave., Plaza Level Suite 202, San Juan, PR 00918**; or **in person at the Energy Bureau’s Clerk’s Office**, located at the aforementioned address. All written comments filed according to these instructions shall include in its title the following: “Public Comments on PREPA’s IRP Filing – Case No. CEPR-AP-2018-0001” and shall be addressed to the Energy Bureau’s Chairman, Edison Avilés Deliz.


