RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On August 30, 2019, Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Request for Extension of Time to Submit Responses to Intervenors' Requirements for Information* ("Motion"). Through its Motion, PREPA requests an extension of the deadline to submit responses to the Requirements of Information ("ROI") issued by four (4) different intervenors in the instant case.¹ PREPA states that the response submission deadlines are August 30, 2019, September 3, 2019 and September 6, 2019.² Furthermore, PREPA states that PREPA's and Siemens' staff have been preparing for the second part of the Initial Technical Hearing to be held on September 4 and 5, 2019, and this has affected their ability to meet the deadlines to respond to the aforementioned ROIs.

Upon review of PREPA's Motion, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** PREPA's request to extend the deadline to respond to the intervenors' ROIs until September 13, 2019. The Energy Bureau **ORDERS** PREPA to respond to the aforementioned requirements **on or before 12:00 p.m. of September 9, 2019.**

Through its Motion, PREPA makes reference to a ROI served on August 21, 2019 by the Non-Profit Intervenors. However, the Energy Bureau has no record of such requirement being filed. Therefore, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** the Non-Profit Intervenors to send a copy, via email, to the Energy Bureau³ of the ROI served on August 21, 2019, **within five (5) days of the notification of this Resolution and Order.**

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** PREPA that noncompliance with the provisions of this Resolution and Order may result in the imposition of administrative fines up to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) per day, per violation, as well as any other administrative


