RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On July 8, 2019, SunEdison Puerto Rico LLC ("SunEdison") filed a document titled *Motion in Compliance with Order Dated June 21, 2019, and for Reconsideration* before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau"). SunEdison requested an additional term of twenty (20) days to execute a non-disclosure agreement with the Puerto Rico Energy Public Policy Program ("EPPP"), to submit its Operational Report to said Program and to provide the Energy Bureau evidence thereof.

On July 31, 2019, the Energy Bureau granted SunEdison's request and ordered SunEdison to file said document by August 6, 2019.


On August 6, 2019, SunEdison filed a document titled *Request for Extension to Comply with Resolution and Order dated July 31, 2019*. SunEdison requested to extend the term to submit evidence of the Operation Report filing at the EPPP by twenty (20) additional days to execute a non-disclosure agreement with the EPPP, submit its Operational Report to said Program, and to provide the Energy Bureau evidence thereof.

On August 26, 2019, SunEdison filed a document titled *Request for Additional Extension to Comply with Resolution and Order Dated July 31, 2019*. On September 16, 2019, SunEdison filed a document titled *Third Request for Extension to Comply with Resolution and Order Dated July 31, 2019*. On the August 26, 2019 document, SunEdison requested to extend the term to submit evidence of the Operation Report filing at the EPPP by twenty (20) additional days. On the September 16, 2019 document SunEdison requested thirty (30) additional days.


Upon examining SunEdison's arguments, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** SunEdison until October 16, 2019 to comply with the Energy Bureau's Order. The Energy Bureau **WARNS** SunEdison that noncompliance with the Energy Bureau orders and regulations is sufficient cause for imposing fines and other administrative penalties, under Act No. 57-2014 and all regulations.


