SUBJECT: Progression's Energy Motion to
Compel and PREPA's Opposition.

RESOLUTION

On September 30, 2019, Progression Energy ("PE") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Progression Energy's Motion to Compel Full and Complete Answers to Interrogatory* ("Motion"). Through its Motion, PE states that the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") failed to provide full and complete substantive responses to PE's first Requirement of Information ("ROI"). Furthermore, PE argues that it is inconceivable that PREPA does not have available the information from which it decided to exclude offshore wind technology from the IRP. Lastly, PE requests the Energy Bureau to consider extending the deadline for Intervenor's written testimony in order for PE to be able to incorporate into PE's testimony the information contained in the responses of the ROI.

On October 4, 2019, PREPA filed a document titled *Opposition to Progression Energy Motion to Compel* ("Opposition"). Through its Opposition, PREPA stated that the Energy Bureau granted several extensions of time to respond to pending requirements of information. Specifically, through the September 23, 2019 Resolution and Order¹ in the instant case, the Energy Bureau granted PREPA until October 11, 2019 to respond to PE's ROI. Therefore, PREPA argued that PE ignored the September 23 Order and requested the Energy Bureau to deny PE's Motion.


Upon review of PE's Motion and PREPA's Opposition, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** PE's Motion. PREPA shall file full and complete responses to PE's first ROI within the timeline established in the September 23 Order. Furthermore, the procedural calendar in the instant case was amended by the September 23 Order in consideration of the time extension provided to PREPA to file responses to pending intervenor ROIs. Therefore, the Energy Bureau will not modify the procedural calendar at this time.
