**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On November 26, 2019, the Not for Profit Intervenors filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Motion Requesting Order to PREPA Concerning Alleged Grid Modernization Plan*. On December 6, 2019, the Energy Bureau issued an Order ("December 6 Order") through which it ordered the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") to, within ten (10) days of the notification date of said Order, show cause as to why the Energy Bureau should not order PREPA to submit the Grid Modernization Plan ("Grid Mod Plan") proposal as an amendment to the Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP").

On December 16, 2019, PREPA filed a document titled *Motion to Show Cause and in Compliance with Order Entered on December 6, 2019* ("Motion"). Through its Motion, PREPA states that the "Grid Mod Plan was developed to serve as a roadmap for the Government of Puerto Rico in working with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to fund the repairing and reconstruction in the energy sector and initiate FEMA's associated program's funding activities".<sup>1</sup> As such, PREPA argues that the "Grid Mod Plan provides guidance related to sources of funds and time lines [sic] of suggested investments and improvements".<sup>2</sup> Additionally, PREPA states that the Grid Mod Plan recognizes the development of a draft IRP and that "the IRP is the official resource plan for PREPA and Puerto Rico, the Grid Mod Plan recommendation, implementation and execution will be adjusted based on the final plan approved by the Energy Bureau".<sup>3</sup>

In light of the above, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** the Not for Profit Intervenors to submit its position regarding PREPA's Motion **within ten (10) days** from the notification date of this Resolution and Order.




