RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On January 31, 2020, Progression Energy filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Urgent Motion for Expert Witness to Appear via Video Conference or Telephone* ("Urgent Motion"). In its Urgent Motion, Progression Energy argued that "[d]ue to unforeseen events on the life of Mr. Banister, it is nearly impossible for him to be present to testify next week."¹

Progression Energy's witness, Mr. Kevin Banister, is scheduled to appear during Panel G at the Evidentiary Hearing in the instant case, scheduled for 4:00 p.m. on February 5, 2020.² An appearance via video conference or telephone is not consistent with the nature and format of the Evidentiary Hearing in the instant case. Therefore, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** Progression Energy's Urgent Motion. The Energy Bureau **WARNS** Progression Energy that the non-appearance of its witness at the designated date and time may result in his pre-filed direct testimony been stricken from the record, in accordance with the provisions of Article XII of Regulation 8543.³
