**NOTICE OF NATIONAL PUBLIC FINANCE GUARANTEE CORPORATION
REGARDING EVIDENTIARY HEARING PARTICIPATION**

Intervenor National Public Finance Guarantee Corporation (“National”), by and through its attorneys at Adsuar Muñoz Goyco Seda & Perez-Ochoa, P.S.C. and Weil, Gotshal & Manges LLP, hereby submits this Notice Regarding Evidentiary Hearing Participation in the Integrated Resource Plan (“IRP”) proceeding.

On January 17, 2020, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (the “Bureau”) issued a Resolution regarding the format and guidelines for an evidentiary hearing in the above-captioned case (the “Evidentiary Hearing”).¹ In particular, the Bureau set the Evidentiary Hearing to begin on February 3, 2020 at 8 a.m. and to continue through February 7, 2020 (with such other extensions as may be deemed appropriate).² The Evidentiary Hearing is divided into ten witness panels; no witness for National is scheduled to appear on any panel.³ Participants in the Evidentiary Hearing will also have the opportunity to question witnesses on the panels.⁴

To assist the Bureau and the Hearing Examiner with scheduling, National hereby notifies its intent not to actively engage as a participant in the Evidentiary Hearing. Consistent with the Bureau's January 17th order, National does not plan to have a witness appear on the panels at the Evidentiary Hearing, and National does not intend at this time to question other parties' witnesses at the Evidentiary Hearing. National will have a representative(s) in attendance at the Evidentiary Hearing, who will be able to answer the Bureau's questions if necessary. National reserves all rights to participate in other stages or aspects of the IRP proceeding, consistent with its status as an intervenor.

WHEREFORE, National respectfully requests that the Bureau and the Hearing Examiner TAKE NOTICE of its intent not to actively engage as a participant in the Evidentiary Hearing.
