SUBJECT: Order with respect to AES-PR's
Motion Requesting Notification Order.

ORDER

On December 26, 2019, AES Puerto Rico, L.P. ("AES-PR") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Motion Requesting Notification Order* ("Motion"). Through its Motion, AES-PR requested the Energy Bureau to order all parties in the instant case to serve "all documents filed or otherwise served in this matter to attorneys Manuel A. Pietrantonio and Alana Pagán".¹ AES-PR argues that there have been several instances in which their legal counsel has not been served with documents or files sent via email by intervenors in the instant case.

AES-PR informed and notified all parties in the instant case of their change in legal counsel through document titled *Joint Motion for Substitution of Counsel for AES-Puerto Rico, L.P.*, filed on September 10, 2019. Moreover, on September 23, 2019, the Energy Bureau granted AES-PR's late intervention in this proceeding,² which was requested through a motion filed by Mr. Pietrantonio and Ms. Pagán.³

It is the parties' responsibility in the instant case to be aware of any change of status or change in the notification information of the other parties. The Energy Bureau **ORDERS** all parties to properly notify AES-PR through their legal counsel Mr. Pietrantonio and Ms. Pagán and **WARNS** that noncompliance with the proper notification of documents in the instant case may result in the imposition of administrative fines up to twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000) per day, per violation, as well as any other administrative sanctions the Energy Bureau deems necessary, in accordance with applicable statutes and regulations.






