**SUBJECT:** Resolution on the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority Request to Include Additional Witnesses for Evidentiary Hearing Panels.

#### RESOLUTION

On January 17, 2020, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution through which it established the format and guidelines that will govern the Evidentiary Hearing in the instant case, scheduled for February 3 – 7, 2020. The Energy Bureau divided the topics and issues to be discussed at the hearing, into ten (10) panels labeled Panel A through Panel J. The Energy Bureau assigned witnesses to each panel based on their pre-filed testimony and/or their answers to discovery questions.

On January 29, 2020, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") filed a document titled *Request to Include Additional Witnesses for Evidentiary Hearing Panels* ("Request"). In its Request, PREPA stated that "[a]fter a careful evaluation of the issues listed and the PREPA officers and consultants that have been summoned, PREPA understand that there is a true need to add certain PREPA officers and consultants as witnesses to address some of the panels' listed issues."<sup>1</sup>

PREPA argued that Dr. Marcelo Saenz and attorney James Bowe should be included as witnesses in certain panels. According to PREPA, Dr. Saenz was a key consultant in the development of the draft Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP"), in preparing model runs and in providing responses to the discovery requests.<sup>2</sup> PREPA argued that it is necessary for Mr. Bowe to appear in additional panels since he is the ideal witness to address some of the issues listed for such panels.<sup>3</sup> PREPA requested the Energy Bureau to include Dr. Saenz as a witness on Panels A, B, D, E, F and G.<sup>4</sup> PREPA also requested to include Mr. Bowe as a witness

on Panel B.<sup>5</sup> After reviewing PREPA's arguments, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** PREPA's request regarding the inclusion of Dr. Saenz and Mr. Bowe as a witness in the abovementioned panels.

PREPA also argued that "[t]he appearance of additional PREPA officers and consultants is necessary to correctly and responsibly address the list of issues to be discussed and for which PREPA's testimony will be elicited." According to PREPA, "[t]he addition of these witnesses will assist PREPA to better inform and educate the Energy Bureau to achieve the ultimate purpose of the Evidentiary Hearing, put the Energy Bureau in a position to make a determination on the matter at hand." PREPA requested the Energy Bureau to include the following personnel as witnesses in the referenced panels:

The main purpose of the Evidentiary Hearing is to provide an opportunity for PREPA, intervenors and the Energy Bureau to **cross-examine the witnesses that provided pre-filed direct testimony and/or provided answers to discovery questions**. Moreover, during Panel A, PREPA will first provide the information related to the topics listed and then the Energy Bureau and the intervenors will proceed with their cross-examination. As such, and based on its nature, Panel A: January 2020 Earthquakes' Effect on Existing Resources and Core IRP Elements, is the only panel that allows for new witnesses or testimony.

All starting

None of the witnesses listed above provided pre-filed direct testimony. However, Eng. Daniel Hernandez Morales, Eng. Luissette Ríos Castañer, Eng. José Vázquez, Eng. Edwin Barbosa and Arturo Deliz, *Esq.* provided answers to certain discovery questions. Therefore, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** PREPA's request regarding the inclusion of these witnesses in the abovementioned panels.

After a thorough search of the documents contained in the instant case's docket, the Energy Bureau could not find pre-filed direct testimony nor answers to discovery questions provided by Eng. José Sepúlveda and Mr. Fernando M. Padilla. Therefore, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** PREPA's request with respect to these witnesses.

On January 30, 2020, PREPA filed a document titled *Request to Include Eng. Gary F. Soto Fernández as Witness in Panel A of Evidentiary Hearing* ("January 30 Request"). Through the January 30 Request, PREPA stated that during a Technical Hearing held in Case No. NEPR-MI-2020-0003, Eng. Gary F. Soto Fernández "was instrumental in providing information and discussing and detailing the technical reasons that led to the January 6 load shed and the January 7 total blackout, the effects of the recent seismic events on PREPA's generation assets and operations and also, the steps taken towards the restoration of the service." It is PREPA's understanding that Eng. Soto is an essential PREPA officer for the discussion of the topics to be addressed during Panel A of the Evidentiary Hearing. Therefore, PREPA requests the Energy Bureau to allow Eng. Soto as a witness in Panel A of the Evidentiary Hearing.

Upon review of the January 30 Request, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** PREPA's request regarding the inclusion of Eng. Soto to Panel A of the Evidentiary Hearing.

A complete witness list is included in Attachment A of this Resolution.9
