SUBJECT: PREPA's Noncompliance with the
January 29 Resolution and Order.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On January 29, 2020, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("January 29 Order")¹ through which, among other things, required the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") to "submit the Aurora model files in readable format for the following runs: S3S2, S4S2 and ESM (base)."² Furthermore, the Energy Bureau required PREPA to provide such information in Excel format or any other suitable format within fifteen (15) days from the notification of the January 29 Order. The term expired on February 13, 2020.³

As of today, PREPA has not complied with the January 29 Order, regarding the submission of the Aurora model files. Therefore, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** PREPA to, **on or before February 28, 2020**, comply with the January 29 Order and submit the Aurora modeling files in a readable format for the following runs: S3S2, S4S2 and ESM (base). PREPA may also file a memorandum of law in support of any confidentiality requests associated with the filing, in accordance with the provisions of the August 31, 2016 Resolution in Case No. CEPR-MI-2016-0009, as amended, for the Energy Bureau's evaluation.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** PREPA that noncompliance with the provisions of Act 57-2014,⁴ the Energy Bureau's regulations and/or the Energy Bureau's orders is sufficient cause for the imposition of fines and other administrative sanctions of up to \$25,000 per day per violation.


