RESOLUTION

As part of the public comment process in the instant case, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") conducted five public hearings in San Juan, Arecibo, Humacao, Mayagüez and Ponce.¹ During the public hearings the Energy Bureau received comments from a variety of persons and organizations. In addition, the Energy Bureau received written comments from the public through its electronic filing system, its designated email and in person at the Energy Bureau's Clerk.

On February 28, 2020, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution ("February 28 Resolution")² through which it modified the procedural calendar in the instant case, in order to provide the parties opportunity to evaluate the comments received as part of the public comment process. Based on the comments received during the public comment process, the Energy Bureau would like the parties in the instant case to address the topics detailed below as part of the Replies to Legal Briefs:³

1. Rooftop Solar: Provide comments on reasonable alternatives to make the transformation of the electrical system viable by using rooftop solar systems in lieu of utility scale solar developments.
2. Hydroelectric Generation: Provide comments on the alternative of rehabilitating the existing hydroelectric plants and dredging the existing reservoirs to optimize their capacity. Comments must address if such costs should be borne by consumers.
3. Virtual Power Plants: Provide comments on the alternative of using virtual power plants (*i.e.* aggregators) as a resource to the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority




("PREPA"), and how these should be incorporated in PREPA's competitive processes for the acquisition of new generation resources.


