RESOLUTION

On February 15, 2019, the Petitioner, David Freedman, filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a Request for Bill Review against the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA"), regarding the invoice dated December 15, 2017 in the amount of \$395.17. The Petitioner filed the Request for Bill Review under the expedited process established in Section 5.04 of Regulation 8863.¹

On October 10, 2019, the Energy Bureau issued a Final Resolution and Order, though which it denied the Request for Bill Review. On October 25, 2019, the Petitioner filed a motion titled *Request for Reconsideration*, pursuant to Section 3.15 of Act 38-2017² and Section 11.01 of Regulation 8542³ ("Request for Reconsideration"). On October 28, 2019 the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution in which it expressly determined that it would evaluate the Request for Reconsideration, pursuant to the provisions of Act 38-2017. Furthermore, on January 23, 2020, the Energy Bureau, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3.15 of Act 38-2017, extended the term to evaluate the Request for Reconsideration.

Upon careful consideration and analysis of the arguments included in the Request for Reconsideration, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** it and **UPHOLDS** the Final Resolution and Order issued on October 10, 2019.

Any affected party may submit a petition for review before the Court of Appeals of Puerto Rico within thirty (30) days, from the notification of this Resolution, pursuant to the



provisions of Article 6.5 of 57-2014⁴, as amended, Section 5.06 of Regulation No. 8863, Section 11.03 of Regulation No. 8543, the provisions of the Act 38-2017, and the Court of Appeals Regulations.

Be it notified and published.






