RESOLUTION AND ORDER

In compliance with the Resolution and Order issued by the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") on March 3, 2020¹, on March 31, 2020, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority's ("PREPA") filed before the Energy Bureau a document titled *Motion to Inform* ("March 31 Compliance Filing"). Through the March 31 Compliance Filing, PREPA submitted a document titled *Costa Sur Damage Assessment and Repairs Project Status Report*, which outlines PREPA's progress in the assessment, repairs and procurement activities aimed to repair the Costa Sur Power Plant facility.²

On April 1, 2020, as required in the March 3, 2020 Resolution and Order, PREPA filed a document titled *Motion to Submit Reports Assessing Damages* ("April 1 Compliance Filing"). The April 1 Compliance Filing contained several reports regarding the inspections conducted at the Costa Sur Site. In the April 1 Compliance Filing, PREPA stated that in order for PREPA to assess the extent of the damages suffered by the Costa Sur Facility, it has to complete thirteen (13) engineering reports, of which a total of eleven (11) were completed and submitted as part of the April 1 Compliance Filing.³ Furthermore, PREPA stated that the two (2) remaining assessments will be submitted as soon as they are completed and final.⁴

Upon review of the abovementioned documents, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** PREPA to attend a Technical Conference meeting to be held via telephone **on April 30, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.** All PREPA representatives pertinent for the discussion of the March 31 Compliance Filing and the April 1 Compliance Filing shall join the Technical Conference. As part of the Technical Conference, PREPA representatives shall have all pertinent documents (*i.e.*, printed and digital) readily available and be prepared to address any questions from the
