**SUBJECT:** Unopposed Request for Brief Extension of Time to Comply with April 28, 2020 Resolution and Order.

## **RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On May 1, 2020, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Unopposed Request for Brief Extension of Time to Comply with April 28, 2020 Resolution and Order* ("Motion"). Through its Motion, PREPA states that after due diligence, it has not been able to gather the necessary information to respond to one of the requests of the April 28, 2020 Resolution and Order¹ in the instant case.² PREPA argues that due to previously scheduled commitments, PREPA could not afford enough time to identify the totality of the required information.³ Therefore, PREPA requested a brief extension until May 1, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. to comply with the April 28 Order.⁴

Upon review of the arguments presented in the Motion, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** PREPA's request. The Energy Bureau **ORDERS** PREPA to file complete responses to the April 28 Order **on or before 6:00 p.m. of May 1, 2020**.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** PREPA that, pursuant to the provisions of Act 57-2014,<sup>5</sup> as amended, noncompliance with the Energy Bureau orders may result in the imposition of fines of up to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), per day, per violation, and any other administrative sanction the Energy Bureau deems necessary, in accordance with current statues and regulations.
