**MOTION TO SUBMIT REVISED APRIL 2020 COST DIFFERENTIAL
ANALYSIS FOR FEMA AND INSURANCE REINBURSEMENT**

TO THE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority through the undersigned legal representation and respectfully submits:

1. On May 20, 2020, PREPA filed the *Motion in Compliance with Order Entered on May 18, 2020* (the “May 20 Motion”). The May 20 Motion included the report of the peaking generation analysis for the months of January to March 2020.¹ The report reflects the cost differential that the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (PREPA) submits to the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the insurance carriers for reimbursement.

2. PREPA herein submits the updated peaking generation report which now includes the cost differential analysis for the month of April 2020.²

WHEREFORE, PREPA respectfully requests the Energy Bureau to note the filing of the attached document which supplements the March 20 Motion.

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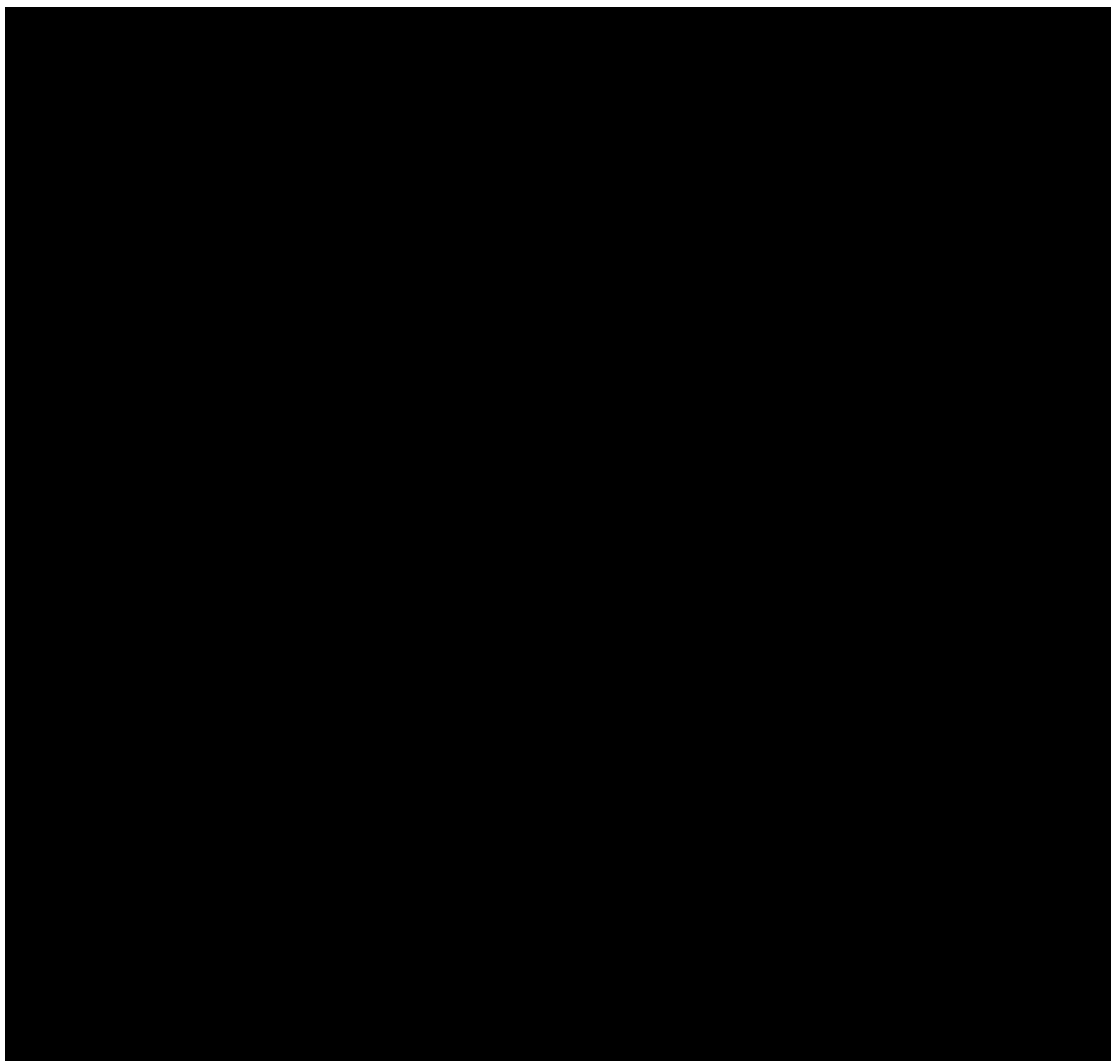
