RESOLUTION

On May 26, 2020, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Request for Leave to Execute Seventeenth Contract Release* ("Motion"). As an attachment to the Motion, PREPA provided the draft Siemens Contract Release 17 ("CR-17"), as ordered on the July 16, 2019 Resolution and Order in the instant case.¹

In the Motion, PREPA stated that the draft CR-17 describes the consulting services to be provided by Siemens and a specific breakdown of the total compensation per task.²

Upon review of PREPA's arguments, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** PREPA's request for leave to execute CR-17. As established in the April 15, 2020 Resolution and Order in the instant case, the deadline for all parties to submit replies to final briefs ended on April 20, 2020.³ The evidentiary proceeding in this case has concluded, and the Energy Bureau is in its deliberative process. As such, new evidence cannot be admitted in the instant case.
