RESOLUTION

On October 14, 2020, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("October 14 Resolution and Order") through which it determined to bifurcate the instant proceeding to include an Interim Unbundled Rate for Wheeling. Through the October 14 Resolution and Order, the Energy Bureau established a proposed Interim Unbundled Rate and requested the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") and interested stakeholders to provide comments to the aforementioned proposed rate.

On October 28, 2020, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution ("October 28 Resolution") through which it informed that it will hold a virtual Technical Conference on November 4, 2020 ("November 4 Conference"), at 9:30 a.m. to discuss the operational and technical issues that need to be resolved to implement wheeling. The Energy Bureau required all PREPA personnel with knowledge on the issues at hand to attend the November 4 Conference. Additionally, the Energy Bureau invited stakeholders interested in participating in the November 4 Conference to inform the Energy Bureau on or before October 30, 2020.

The November 4 Conference will follow a workshop format. Moreover, the Energy Bureau is interested in obtaining information from PREPA and stakeholders on the following topics:

1. Appropriate discount for Wheeling Customers.
2. Balancing Function.
3. Uniform Service Agreements.
4. Responsibility for metering and billing.
5. Allocation for partial payment.
6. Payment guarantees in the event of an Electric Power Service Company default.
7. Stand-by rates.

- 9. Other operational or technical issues.




