RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On October 14, 2020, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("October 14 Resolution and Order") through which it determined to bifurcate the instant proceeding to include an Interim Unbundled Rate for Wheeling. Through the October 14 Resolution and Order, the Energy Bureau established a proposed Interim Unbundled Rate and requested the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") and interested stakeholders to provide comments to the aforementioned proposed rate.

The Energy Bureau also ordered PREPA to attend a virtual Technical Conference on October 22, 2020, at 1:00 p.m.,¹ with the purpose of discussing PREPA's fuel and purchased power costs, any potential credit for the wheeling customer for avoided generation capacity as well as any issues PREPA might raise towards the implementation of the Interim Unbundled Rate. Further, PREPA shall provide information and recommendations for a charge to cover its costs associated with implementing wheeling. Additionally, the Energy Bureau will hold a virtual Technical Conference on November 4, 2020, at 9:30 a.m. to discuss the operational and technical issues that need to be resolved to implement wheeling.² The Energy Bureau requires all PREPA personnel with knowledge on the referenced matters to attend the virtual Technical Conferences.

On October 19, 2020, PREPA filed before the Energy Bureau a document titled *Request for Modification of the Procedural Calendar Set Forth in the October 14, 2020 Resolution and Order* ("Motion"). Through its Motion, PREPA argued that it cannot responsibly appear at the October 22, 2020 Technical Conference to discuss such important and complex topics.³ Further, PREPA stated that it cannot meet the deadlines included in the procedural calendar set forth in the October 14 Resolution and Order.⁴

Additionally, the Energy Bureau **INFORMS** that the virtual Technical Conference will be held in the English language and will be streamed live, in English and Spanish, via the Energy Bureau's Youtube Channel. All provisions of the October 14 Resolution and Order remain in effect.


