TO THE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

Now comes Instituto de Competitividad y Sostenibilidad Económica de Puerto Rico (ICSE) represented by appearing counsel and respectfully alleges and prays:

1. On November 16, 2020 the local environmental organizations filed a motion aimed at guarantying the most ample public participation in the implementation of the recently approved IRP.
2. It is ICSE's judgment that such maximum possible participation of interested parties is better protected and promoted by continuing using the current IRP docket for its implementation phase instead of opening a new docket.
3. The opening of a new docket brings about the formalities and the need to file new appearances, justifying again the interest of the parties, issue of standing, which have already been taken care in the IRP proceeding.

The ICSE respectfully supports the LEO Motion and request the PREB to continue he "new" docket not as a "new" one, but as part of the original IRP Process docket.


WHEREFORE, It is respectfully requested from PREB to continue the implementation phase of the IRP as part of the original proceedings.
