SUBJECT: Order for PREPA to file 10-Year
Infrastructure Plan.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On December 22, 2020, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order¹ through which it opened the instant docket to initiate the Optimization Proceeding in order to attain increased electric power system resiliency, as described in the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") Approved Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP") and Modified Action Plan.²

The Energy Bureau became aware of the availability of a document titled *PREPA 10-Year Infrastructure Plan December 2020* at PREPA's website. The mentioned document was apparently submitted by PREPA to the Federal Emergency Management Administration ("FEMA"). Due to the importance of the aforementioned document, and its relevance to the instant case, the Energy Bureau **ORDERS** PREPA to:

1. File a true and exact copy of the *PREPA 10-Year Infrastructure Plan December 2020* that PREPA submitted to the FEMA and any related attachments, forms or communications included in the filing of the mentioned document, **on or before 12:00 pm of December 31, 2020;**
2. Attend a Technical Conference to be held remotely on **January 11, 2021 at 10:00 am³** which will be streamed live via the Energy Bureau's You Tube Channel;
3. Ensure that PREPA representatives involved in the preparation of the mentioned plan including, but not limited to, Mr. Fernando Padilla and the relevant personnel from the PREPA's Planning Division and PREPA's Project Management Office attend the Technical Conference.



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

5. File a copy of the foregoing presentation with the Energy Bureau **no later than January 8, 2021.**
