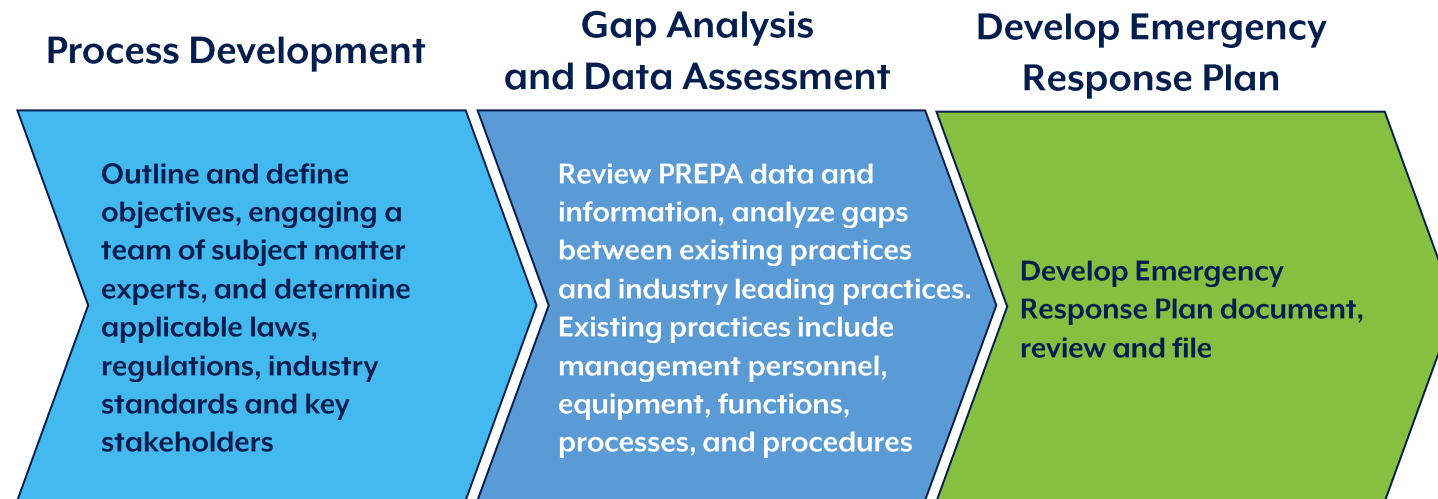

Process and Scope

LUMA's Emergency Response Plan will address electric emergency response to customer outages caused by weather, including thunderstorms, hurricanes, and other natural (e.g., earthquakes, tsunamis, etc.) or manmade causes (e.g., major equipment failure, civil unrest, terrorism, wildfire, etc.) or disasters causing significant customer interruptions. Through the Major Outage Restoration Annex included in the plan, it also operationalizes the sequence of energy restoration revolving around key infrastructure that supports the protection of life and property.

The plan describes LUMA's approach to incident operations and the coordination structure(s) that implement them. It also contains stabilization and restoration end-states. In addition, the Plan provides an incident management structure for coordinating and deploying the essential resources necessary for LUMA's response.
