MOTION TO SUBMIT THE PUERTO RICO ELECTRIC POWER AUTHORITY'S QUATERLY PERFORMANCE METRICS

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority through the undersigned legal representation and respectfully sets forth and prays as follows:

On May 14, 2019, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Service Regulatory Board (the "Energy Bureau") issued a *Resolution and Order*¹ directing the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (PREPA) to track certain key performance indicators/metrics² on a monthly basis, and to submit a quarterly report with the information gathered ("Performance Metrics Quarterly Report"). On December 30, 2020, the Energy Bureau issued a *Resolution and Order*³ directing PREPA to file the Performance Metrics Quarterly Reports on the 20th day after each closing quarter, beginning in March 2021.⁴
