**INFORMATIVE MOTION REGARDING GIS DATA
COLLECTION REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL**

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COMES NOW the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (the “Authority”) through the undersigned counsel and respectfully submits and requests as follows:

1. On December 31, 2020, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (the “Energy Bureau”) issued a *Resolution and Order*¹ directing LUMA² and the Authority to complete several tasks, including: (1) creation of voltage level maps, to be completed by May 31, 2021; (2) creation of preliminary maps of interconnection capacity, to be completed by September 30, 2021; and (3) updating and completing a power grid inventory, to be completed by December 31, 2021. The Order also directed the Authority and LUMA to submit a joint work schedule for each project.

2. On April 13, 2021, the Energy Bureau held a second Compliance Hearing in the case of caption where the Authority and LUMA offered a presentation to deliver updates on the status of projects to comply with the Order. During the Compliance Hearing the Authority’s officials informed the Energy Bureau that, to comply Task 3 of the Order, the Authority had to issue a request for proposals (RFP) to award a professional services contract to conduct a geographic

information system (GIS) field survey data collection. The Energy Bureau emphasized on the importance of this RFP and ordered the Authority to update the Energy Bureau on the status of the RFP publication.

3. The RFP document with its respective annexes was prepared by the Authority's consultant, Burns & McDonnell Caribbean (Puerto Rico), P-LLC ("Burns and McDonnell"), together with a team of the Authority's Information Technology and Transmission and Distribution directorates, as well as LUMA. On April 12, 2021, Burns & McDonnell sent to the Authority a final version with several changes that LUMA proposes. These revisions were reviewed by the Authority's Information Technology officials who, in turn, provided further comments to the draft. The revisions were submitted to the Burns and McDonnell team. Once it is confirmed that all the concerning parties agree to the final version of the RFP, the Authority's Project Management Office will publish the RFP.

4. The Authority will continue to inform the Energy Bureau regarding the RFP status when information is updated.

WHEREFORE, the Authority requests the Energy Bureau to note the above mentioned.
