**MOTION SUBMITTING REPORT ON JUNE 10<sup>TH</sup> INCIDENT AND REQUEST FOR  
CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT**

**TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:**

COME NOW LUMA Energy, LLC (“ManagementCo”), and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC (“ServCo”), (jointly referred to as the “Operator” or “LUMA”), and respectfully state and request the following:

1. On June 11, 2021, this honorable Puerto Rico Energy Bureau (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“June 11<sup>th</sup> Order”) whereby it initiated an investigation on the incident that took place on June 10, 2021 at the Monacillos substation in San Juan that involved outages in certain areas of Puerto Rico (hereinafter, “the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident”).

2. On June 14, 2021, LUMA submitted a report of the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident that included basic information as well as preliminary findings on the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident. LUMA informed that it would need at least six weeks to submit an initial report on the June 10<sup>th</sup> incident.

3. On June 16, 2021, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order that fixed July 30, 2021, as the date for LUMA to file a root cause report of the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident (“June 16<sup>th</sup> Order”). *See* June 16<sup>th</sup> Order at page 4. The Energy Bureau also directed that it could grant an extension of the deadline for good cause. *Id.*

4. As requested by this honorable Energy Bureau, LUMA is submitting today, under seal of confidentiality, a report entitled “Analysis for Monacillos Fault Event on 6/10/21” (“Monacillos Report”). The Monacillos Report is based on the forensic analysis of the electrical system disturbance that caused a fire emergency at the Monacillos Transmission Center and a widespread power outage on Thursday, June 10, 2021.

5. LUMA has already begun to address issues identified in the investigation of the event. LUMA’s current actions include further technical reviews, engineering design modifications, and operational changes. LUMA will do this work as part of its overall remediation of the Puerto Rico electrical system and in particular the modernization of key transmission and distribution substations, such as Monacillos. Taking these steps will improve the safe operation of the system, prevent the loss of property, and avoid service interruptions to customers.

6. LUMA is also submitting via email a confidential SCADA Report. Exhibit 2. LUMA will also submit with PREB, via personal delivery, a confidential video of the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident. Exhibit 3.

7. In the June 16<sup>th</sup> Order, the Energy Bureau directed that materials regarding the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident and the pending investigation would be maintained confidential as allowed by Section 15.10 of Regulation Number 8543, on Adjudicative, Notice of Noncompliance, Rate Review and Investigation Proceedings. Pursuant to that directive of the Energy Bureau, LUMA submits the Monacillos Report, the SCADA Report and a video of the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident under seal of confidentiality and requests that the Energy Bureau receive and maintain the same confidentially.

8. Given that Section 15.10 of Regulation Number 8543 allows for release to the public of information after an investigation has concluded, LUMA respectfully submits that the

Monacillos Report, the SCADA Report and the video of the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident should be designated as confidential materials that should be protected from disclosure after the investigation on the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident concludes. As will be explained in the Memorandum of Law on Confidentiality to be filed expediently within the next ten days, the documents and video are protected from disclosure as Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (“CEII”), *see e.g.*, 6 U.S.C. §§ 671-674; 18 C.F.R. §388.113 (2020), and pursuant to the Bureau’s Policy on Management of Confidential Information. *See* Energy Bureau’s Policy on Management of Confidential Information, CEPR-MI-2016-0009 (“Policy on Management of Confidential Information”), issued on August 31, 2016, as amended by the Resolution dated September 16, 2016.

**WHEREFORE**, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau **take notice** of the aforementioned, **accept** the Monacillos Report, the SCADA Report and the video of the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident, **treat them confidentially**, and **deem** that LUMA complied with the June 16<sup>th</sup> Order requiring a root cause report on the June 10<sup>th</sup> Incident.
