RESOLUTION

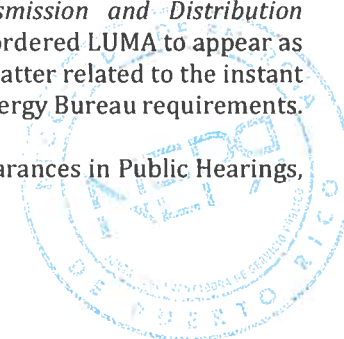
On February 5, 2021, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("February 5 Order") in the instant case regarding the establishment of unbundled rates for wheeling. Through the February 5 Order, the Energy Bureau, among other things, established a procedural calendar for the evaluation of the proposed unbundled rate required to be filed by the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA").¹

On June 22, 2021, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("June 22 Resolution") through which it amended the procedural calendar established in the February 5 Order. The Energy Bureau scheduled a Public Hearing to be held on August 12, 2021.

Through this Resolution, the Energy Bureau **INFORMS** that the Public Hearing will be held remotely via the *Microsoft Teams* platform **on August 12, 2021, from 10:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.** In accordance with the provisions of the Resolution issued by the Energy Bureau in Case No. NEPR-MI-2021-0010², the public will have the opportunity to present their opinion and comments about the proposed unbundled rate during the Virtual Public Hearing. Since the Virtual Public Hearing is designed to obtain comments from the public, LUMA or its employees, associates, witnesses or legal representation, and any other party to this proceeding will not be allowed to participate in the Virtual Public Hearing. Any person interested in presenting oral comments during the Virtual Public Hearing shall, on or before **Wednesday, August 11, 2021 at 3:00 p.m.**, contact the Energy Bureau's Clerk at (787) 523-6262 or via email to secretaria@jrsp.pr.gov to request a turn and to obtain instructions and

¹ Note that on June 1, 2021, LUMA Energy, LLC as ManagementCo, and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC as ServCo (together, "LUMA") commenced its operations pursuant to the *Puerto Rico Transmission and Distribution Operation and Maintenance Agreement* ("OMA") and the *Puerto Rico Transmission and Distribution Supplemental Terms Agreement* ("Supplemental Agreement"). The Energy Bureau ordered LUMA to appear as part of the instant case, determined LUMA shall be responsible for attending any matter related to the instant case and required LUMA and PREPA to coordinate any efforts to comply with the Energy Bureau requirements.
