SUBJECT: LUMA Request for Extension of Time to Comply with Resolution and Order of November 16, 2021.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On June 11, 2021, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order (“June 11 Resolution”) initiating an investigation on the incident on June 10, 2021, at the Monacillos substation in San Juan, property of the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (“June 10 Incident”).

On November 16, 2021, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order (“November 16 Order”) in which ordered LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC¹ (“LUMA”) to provide comments on or before November 23, 2021, to a document entitled *Analytical Comments on the LUMA Energy Report on the Major Blackout of June 10, 2021* (“Analytical Comments”), that was filed on September 3, 2021 by Engineer Carlos H. Díaz Rivera (“Eng. Díaz-Rivera”).

On November 23, 2021, LUMA filed a document titled *Urgent Request for Extension of Time to Comply with November 16th Resolution and Order on June 10th Incident Investigation* (“November 23 Request”). Through the November 23 Request, LUMA requests the Energy Bureau an extension of time until December 10, 2021, to comply with the November 16 Order.

In the November 23 Request, LUMA states that the Analytical Comments filed by Eng. Díaz-Rivera contain an interpretation and portrayal of the causes of the June 10 Incident, a rendition of facts that Eng. Díaz-Rivera argues led to the outages in several regions of Puerto Rico, and comments on how an investigation of the incident should develop. Also, LUMA sustain that the Analytical Comments include statements on a prior outage event that occurred in the year 2016 when LUMA did not operate the Transmission and Distribution System. Finally, the Analytical Comments include six conclusions. Accordingly, LUMA’s alleged that the response to the Analytical Comments requires that LUMA personnel invest considerable time in studying the facts, inferences, conclusions and arguments of Eng. Díaz-Rivera. Therefore, LUMA sustain that is a time-consuming endeavor that could not reasonably be concluded in the five business days that the Energy Bureau fixed in the November 16 Order.

LUMA requested the Energy Bureau an extension of time to analyze the Analytical Comments and draft valuable comments to aid the Energy Bureau in its investigation. Therefore, LUMA requests an extension of time until December 10, 2021, to comply with the November 16 Order.

Upon review of LUMA’s arguments, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** LUMA’s request and **ORDERS** LUMA to file their comments to the document entitled *Analytical Comments on the LUMA Energy Report on the Major Blackout of June 10, 2021*, **on or before December 10, 2021**.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** LUMA that, noncompliance with any provision of this Resolution and Order, may result in the imposition of fines pursuant to Act 57-2014² and applicable




Energy Bureau's regulations and any other appropriate administrative sanctions, as deemed appropriate by the Energy Bureau.
