SUBJECT: LUMA's Urgent Request for an
Extension of Time to File Rebuttal
Testimony of Witness Mario Hurtado.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On January 10, 2022, LUMA Energy, LLC ManagementCo (as "ManagementCo"), and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC2 (as "ServCo") (collectively, "LUMA"), filed a document titled *LUMA's Request for this Energy Bureau to Modify the Procedural Calendar set forth in the Resolution and Order of December 22, 2021*, to request the modification of the procedural calendar in this instant proceeding.

On January 14, 2022, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order ("January 14 Resolution") through which, among other, amended the Procedural Calendar established through the December 22 Resolution¹. The Energy Bureau set February 1, 2022, as the deadline for LUMA to submit its witnesses' rebuttal testimonies on the intervenors' witnesses' testimonies, among other modifications.

On January 28, 2022, LUMA filed a document titled *LUMA's Request for an Extension of Time to File Rebuttal Testimonies*, asking the Energy Bureau to extend the timeframe to file the rebuttal testimonies to February 17, 2022.

On January 31, 2022, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("January 31 Resolution") through which, it amended the Procedural Calendar established and extended the timeframe for LUMA to file the rebuttal testimonies to February 17, 2022.

On February 1, 2022, LUMA filed a document titled *Motion Submitting Rebuttal Testimonies*. LUMA submitted the rebuttal testimonies of five of its witnesses and reiterated that the remaining testimonies would be filed by the set date of February 17, 2022.

On February 15, 2022, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("February 15 Resolution"), among other, granting all parties ten (10) days to conduct discovery from LUMA's filing of Rebuttal on Intervenors Written Testimonies, which were due February 17, 2022.

On February 16, 2022, LUMA filed a document titled *LUMA's Urgent Request for an Extension of Time to File Rebuttal Testimony of Witness Mario Hurtado* ("February 16 Request"), where LUMA seeks an extension of time of the February 17, 2022 deadline, regarding the rebuttal testimony of Mario Hurtado.

In the February 16 Request, LUMA states, that they filed the outstanding rebuttal testimonies by the deadline ordered by the Energy Bureau. However, one of LUMA's witnesses, Mr. Mario Hurtado, had an unexpected family emergency outside the jurisdiction of Puerto Rico that makes it unattainable for him to finalize his testimony by the due date of February 17, 2022. **Therefore, LUMA requests an extension until February 25, 2022, to file Mario Hurtado rebuttal testimony.** LUMA sustains that the extension request is made in good faith and does not intend to cause undue delay in the instant proceeding.

Upon review of LUMA's arguments, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** LUMA's request and **ORDERS** LUMA's to submit the rebuttal testimony of witness Mario Hurtado, no later than



February 25, 2022. Therefore, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** all parties and intervenors **ten (10) days** from LUMA's filing of Mario Hurtado rebuttal testimony to submit any additional discovery related solely to such rebuttal written testimony of witness Mario Hurtado. All other matters addressed in the February 15 Resolution remain unaltered.

The Energy Bureau **WARNS** LUMA's that, noncompliance with any provision of this Resolution and Order, may result in the imposition of fines pursuant to Act 57-2014² and applicable Energy Bureau's regulations and any other appropriate administrative sanctions, as deemed appropriate by the Energy Bureau.


