**URGENT REQUEST FOR BRIEF EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT
SUMMARY IN SPANISH OF LUMA'S REVISED PERFORMANCE METRICS

TO THE HONORABLE PUERTO RICO ENERGY BUREAU:

COME now LUMA Energy, LLC ("ManagementCo"), and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC ("ServCo") (jointly "LUMA"), and respectfully state and request the following:

1. On January 14, 2022, the Puerto Rico Energy Bureau ("Energy Bureau") issued a Resolution and Order requiring LUMA to file by February 4, 2022, a summary in Spanish of LUMA's Revised Performance Metrics Targets ("January 14th Order").
2. LUMA is currently in the process of editing the summary in Spanish of LUMA's Revised Proposed Performance Metrics Targets. This process requires input from LUMA's subject-matter experts to ensure accuracy in translating technical terms to Spanish. Thus, additional time is needed to ensure that the summary communicates correctly and effectively, valuable information to LUMA's customers, stakeholders and the public.
3. Accordingly, LUMA respectfully requests a brief extension of five (5) business days, up to and including February 11, 2022, to file the summary in Spanish of LUMA's Revised Performance Metrics Targets.

4. This request for a brief extension of time is made in good faith. The request should not delay proceedings, given that the next procedural event is scheduled for February 17, 2022.

WHEREFORE, LUMA respectfully requests that the Energy Bureau **take** notice of the above and **grant** an extension of time of five (5) business days up to and including February 11, 2022, to file the Summary in Spanish of LUMA’s Revised Performance Metrics Targets.
