Ongoing PREB-Led Processes

- Puerto Rico Test for cost-effectiveness
 - Energy Bureau issued a framework for comment on February 7
 - Comments filed March 7
 - Energy Bureau to consider comments and order final PR Test
 - May request additional feedback regarding appropriate values to use for adders, etc.



Ongoing PREB-Led Processes

➤ Avoided Cost Study

- Designed to provide values for use in the PR Test
- Workshop on avoided energy cost February 8, 2022
 - Follow-up comments received
- Next priorities: avoided capacity and avoided GHG emissions
- Then: quantify the other aspects of the approved PR Test



Ongoing PREB-Led Processes

- Market Baseline and Potential Studies
 - RFP to be issued soon
 - Target is to have experts under contract in the summer
 - ~18-month timeframe to completion
 - Completed winter 2023-24
