**SUBJECT:** Request for extension of time to file gross revenue report; and confidential treatment of information for the Operational Report.

**RESOLUTION AND ORDER**

On February 25, 2022, Sunnova Management, LLC ("Sunnova") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Request for Extension to Inform Gross Revenues* ("February 25 Request"). Sunnova had until March 1, 2022, to report its gross revenues to the Energy Bureau since its fiscal year ended December 31, 2021.<sup>1</sup> In the February 25 Request, Sunnova states that it requires an extension of ninety (90) days to report its gross revenues since Sunnova is wholly owned by Sunnova Energy Corporation, which usually prepares consolidated financial statement for all subsidiaries in the states and territories of the United States.<sup>2</sup> Sunnova request until May 25, 2022, to file its gross revenue report.<sup>3</sup>

On March 31, 2022, Sunnova filed a document titled *Operational Report* ("Operational Report").<sup>4</sup> On the same day, Sunnova filed a document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of 2022 Operational Report and to Request Remedies* ("March 31 Request"). In the March 31 Request, Sunnova states that disclosure of the Operational Report would cause economic harm and would also put Sunnova in a disadvantage.<sup>5</sup>

Act No. 57-2014 establishes that any person having the obligation to submit information to the Energy Bureau, may request that any information deemed privileged or confidential be treated in such fashion<sup>6</sup>. Specifically, Act 57-2014 requires from the Energy Bureau to treat as confidential the information submitted provided that "after the appropriate evaluation, believes such information should be protected"<sup>7</sup>. In such case, "the Energy Bureau shall grant such protection in a manner that least affects the public interest, transparency, and the rights of the parties involved in the administrative procedure in which the allegedly confidential document is submitted"<sup>8</sup>.

Upon a thorough examination of the arguments brought forth by Sunnova, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** confidential designation and treatment to the Operational Report, filed under Article 6.15 of Act 57-2014. The Energy Bureau **GRANTS** the extension requested and **ORDERS** Sunnova to file its gross revenue report on or before May 25, 2022.
