**SUBJECT:** Financial Report and Operational  
Report request for confidential treatment.

**RESOLUTION**

On March 1, 2022, Sunrun, Inc. ("Sunrun") filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Gross Revenue and Financial Statement Report* ("Financial Report"). The Financial Report contained the following Annexes:

1. Complied financial statements.
2. Audited financial statements.
3. Total Revenues Exhibit.

On the same day, March 1, 2022, Sunrun filed a document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of Financial Information for Fiscal Year 2021* ("March 1 Request"). In the March 1 Request, Sunrun states that even though it is a publicly traded company, its financial information, regarding Puerto Rico revenues is of sensitive nature and its disclosure would place it at a competitive disadvantage and cause it economic harm.<sup>1</sup>

On March 29, 2022, Sunrun filed a document titled *Request for Extension to File 2022 Operational Report* ("March 29 Request").<sup>2</sup>

On April 29, 2022, Sunrun filed a document titled *Operational Report* ("Operational Report"), The Operational Report included: i) Operational Report (Form NEPR-B03); and ii) 2022 Operational Report Annexes.

On April 29, 2022, Sunrun filed a document titled *Motion to Request Confidential Treatment of 2022 Operational Report and Other* ("April 29 Request"), *Remedies*, as provided in Section 6.15 of Act 57-2014<sup>3</sup>, and Section 1.15 of Regulation No. 8701<sup>4</sup>. In the April 29 Request, Sunrun alleges that the Operational Report includes sensitive information and disclosure to the public would cause economic harm and create a disadvantage to Sunrun.<sup>5</sup>

Act 57-2014 establishes that any person having the obligation to submit information to the Energy Bureau, may request that any information that is deemed privileged or confidential be treated in such fashion<sup>6</sup>. Specifically, Act 57-2014 requires from the Energy Bureau to treat as confidential the information submitted provided that "after the appropriate evaluation, believes such information should be protected"<sup>7</sup>. In such case, "the Energy Bureau shall grant such protection in a manner that least affects the public interest,



transparency, and the rights of the parties involved in the administrative procedure in which the allegedly confidential document is submitted”<sup>8</sup>.

Upon a thorough examination of the arguments brought forth by Sunrun, the Energy Bureau **GRANTS** the confidential designation and treatment to the Financial Report and Operational Report as filed, in accordance with Article 6.15 of Act 57-2014.
