SUBJECT: Resolution and Order regarding *Urgente Solicitud para Posposición de Conferencia Técnica*, filed by the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority and *Opposition to Urgente Solicitud para Posposición de Conferencia Técnica*, filed by LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC.

RESOLUTION AND ORDER

On June 17, 2022, the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Service Regulatory Board (“Energy Bureau”) issued a Resolution and Order through which it scheduled a Technical Conference to be held remotely on Friday, June 24, 2022, at 10:00 a.m.

On June 22, 2022, the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (“PREPA”) filed before the Energy Bureau a document titled *Urgente Solicitud para Posposición de Conferencia Técnica* (“June 22 Motion”) through which it requested a continuance of the Technical Conference for next week on the grounds that PREPA’s relevant personnel would be unavailable to testify.

On June 22, 2022, LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC (“LUMA”) filed before the Energy Bureau a document titled *Opposition to Urgente Solicitud para Posposición de Conferencia Técnica* (“Opposition”). In its Opposition, LUMA maintained that the personnel that worked on the underlying technical data for the submissions filed before the Energy Bureau in the past weeks would be unavailable next week due to prior commitments outside the jurisdiction of Puerto Rico, and internet access would not be readily available. Furthermore, LUMA asserted those commitments could not be cancelled at this juncture and argued said personnel’s testimony could not be replaced. LUMA also stated that PREPA’s request was unreasonable considering the tight timeframe in which the Energy Bureau must enter a determination on the matters at issue.

Upon review the June 22 Motion and the Opposition, the Energy Bureau **DENIES** PREPA’s request for continuance of the Virtual Technical Conference. Therefore, the Virtual Technical Conference will be held as scheduled.
